Please read the School Operating Guide (sent via Konnective this afternoon) in preparation for the very exciting return of the whole school next week. Key points are as follows:

Drop Off

- Drop off is staggered from 8.45am- 9.05am. No parents allowed on-site. Do not congregate around the gates, please leave as soon as you have dropped off.
- Kiss'N'Go is a no parking zone. Do not leave your vehicle. Do not wait in these areas in your car for longer than 2 minutes.
- Teacher Carpark (N) for Prep drop off only, if required.
- Students need to bring a full drink bottle and a personal bottle of hand sanitiser.
- Break times will be staggered.

Pick up

- Prep, Grade 1 and any siblings of those children to leave at 3.15pm each day.
- Grade 2-6 students to leave at 3.30pm. No parents on-site.
- Grade 2-6 parents, please do not arrive early for pick up. This defeats the purpose of a staggered pick up.
- Kiss'N'Go is a "No Parking" zone. Do not leave your vehicle. Do not wait in these areas in your car for longer than 2 minutes.
- All parents are asked to leave the vicinity of the school as soon as they have located their children.
- Gates close at 3.40pm
