We would like to thank everyone in the school community for the understanding and compliance regarding the communication sent in relation to COVID-19. As you are aware, the circumstances are changing daily, but we endeavour to keep you informed with the most up to date from the Department of Education and Training and The Department of Health and Human Resources.

We would like to draw your attention to some reminders about the current situation and highlight some changes that we have made at Coatesville Primary School.

- Increased health and hygiene practices and education throughout the school
- Canteen over the counter sales closed
- Regular cleaning of high touch surfaces such as tables and door handles
- Encouraging social distancing across the school and at drop off and pick up times
- Cancellation of whole school and cross cohort events
- Cancellation of excursions and interschool sport

- Cancellation of afterschool activities including Art Smart, Hebrew, Code Camp and Soccerwise.
- Cancellation of cross cohort lunchtime activities such as LEGO Club and Coding Club

Bikes on the Footpath

Every day before and after school there are many people walking, riding, scooting and skating around Coatesville. We would like to remind our students, staff and parents of a couple of rules to ensure the safety of everyone in our community.

For those riding on a shared path you must keep to the left and give way to pedestrians. Pedestrians include people walking, using wheelchairs or mobility scooters, on rollerblades, roller-skates, skateboards or something similar. When overtaking pedestrians, ensure you ring your bell in advance, slow down and make sure you leave enough space between your bike and the pedestrian.

As a pedestrian using the footpath, please be aware that it is *legal* for Primary School aged students to ride their bikes on these footpaths. Please ensure you remain alert and allow plenty of space for bikes to pass you. In order to stay alert we encourage you to not use your phone or other devices that may cause a distraction.
